AutoCAD [Updated]

The working title for AutoCAD was "Automatic Dimensional". AutoCAD was originally intended to replace or complement the drafting and graphics tools available in the AutoLISP language. Based on the technology available at the time, the original specification and implementation of AutoCAD allowed a single user to use a single graphics terminal to interact with the software, and to create drawings that were then saved to a database file. From its earliest days, AutoCAD was originally bundled with AutoLISP, which offered pre-defined functions for handling drawing and editing. The earliest version of AutoCAD, Version 1, supported drawing and editing, and had no integrated database capability. Version 2, released in 1987, introduced built-in database features. The drafting capability of Version 3, released in 1991, was made available as a stand-alone product. In the same year, AutoCAD LT (Light Table) was released. In the same year, AutoCAD was bought by Autodesk, Inc. from Aesop. Autodesk's CEO John Foster stated in a November 2008 company earnings call that "at the end of 2008, roughly 25% of the market for AutoCAD was online". The total figure includes the desktop and mobile versions, and the online productivity tools. At the time of the call, the company stated that AutoCAD had 100 million users. AutoCAD is available for use on desktops running Microsoft Windows operating systems (including Mac OS X), Windows Server, Linux and Mac OS X. AutoCAD applications for mobile devices, including the tablet and smartphone versions of AutoCAD, are available for Android, iOS, Windows Phone and Windows 8. The applications for mobile devices provide a richer user experience than AutoCAD on the desktop. All mobile apps use a virtual pen, similar to the features of Apple's iPad and other tablets. AutoCAD is also available as a web-based application. This allows users to access AutoCAD files on the web browser of their choice, as opposed to requiring an AutoCAD application installed on a personal computer. Web-based AutoCAD is available for the desktop as well as the mobile versions. "Create" is the command to open the drawing and "Save" is the command to save it. Microsoft Office 2011 did not include AutoCAD, and the Windows-only AutoCAD 2011 was not updated for Windows 8. AutoCAD 2013 was released for Windows 7, Windows 8 and Windows 8.1, but had to be purchased separately for Windows 8 and Windows 8.1. In April 2012, AutoCAD 2013 for Windows 8 and Windows 8.1 was replaced by AutoCAD for Windows 10. Windows 10 was initially not compatible with the Windows XP and Windows Vista drivers, but those problems were eventually fixed. AutoCAD 2017 became the first version of AutoCAD to support AutoCAD LT, while AutoCAD LT 2016 was the first AutoCAD LT to support 3D, although 3D drawings could be viewed in AutoCAD 2017. Following the release of AutoCAD 2017, the only public Beta release of AutoCAD 2018 for Windows 10 was released in May 2017 and was discontinued in July 2018 after releasing the final version of AutoCAD 2018. Mobile AutoCAD for Mobile is a set of apps for iOS and Android mobile devices. It can import, edit and create drawings on mobile. Version 1.0 was released in August 2012, Version 1.1 in August 2013, Version 1.2 in May 2014 and Version 2.0 in October 2015. As of June 2018, it is still in beta version for Android and iOS.
